- There will be a new format for the monthly Service Study on the second Monday at 6:00-7:00pm on Zoom. We will be studying the "12 Concepts Illustrated" pamphlet, reviewing each Concept in the corresponding month.

- Beginning in January, we will have a monthly "Group History" segment at our District meeting. Our first Group will

- Since our last meeting, the **Plain Language Big Book** has been released, and a revision is already planned! The first printing of 70,000 copies sold out in two weeks, and the revisions will be included in the second printing.
- O It was recently announced that the 2024/2025 "A.A. Service Manual/Twelve Concepts for World Services" Manual is available online and will soon be available for purchase. The current Manual sells for \$4.00. We have discussed purchasing a new Service Manual for our participants. There are currently 27 GSRs, 7 Alternates and 6 Officers/Appointees who are not GSRs. This would be up to 40 books (we can ask members if they prefer an online version, which is free). I can survey the members and bring a proposal to the District meeting when the print edition is released.
- The Area 07 Registrar has resigned, and a new Registrar will be elected at the Winter Assembly. Current DCMs, Area Officers, and a nominee from each District can also be considered.
- There were four applicants for the two GSR Scholarships for the Winter Assembly. When meeting with my Sponsor, we put the names in a cup (substituting for a hat! (a)) and she pulled two at random. Congrats to Peggy R/GSR for Newcastle Monday Night BB Study, and to Ron C/GSR for the Roseville Happy Destiny Group! The Area Committee is working to make the Winter Assembly hybrid, but no announcement has been made.
- It was reported at the November Area Committee Meeting that there will be a motion brought forward at the Winter Assembly to establish an **Area 07 Accessibilities Committee**. We in District 21 should consider ourselves well-informed, given the recent presentation. I will keep you updated.
