- Attended Mini PRAASA 14,15,16 October.
 - H&I committee expanded scope to include elderly facilities and homeless shelters. Updated committee structure to include Area committee chairs as voting members
 - Hispanic Women's conference is on Dec 3rd in San Diego
 - Young People will hold the Young People's international conference over Labor Day in 2023 in San Francisco
 - Northern California Accessibilities needs volunteers. Primary role is to provide rides to people who cannot drive (blind, elderly, etc.)
 - eServices is working on an updated version of the Area Website, looking great...goal is to release in time for the Winter Assembly
 - Registrar-please let Laura know if you aren't receiving Accents. Suggest to receive them electronically-much lower cost than print and mail
 - Finance-Spending Plan for 2023 approved with two line items to be resolved. There was some confusion about why we are funding special workers or professional translation. To be resolved by Winter Assembly. Passed the motion to allow for more flexibility in approval for use of a limited amount of monies above the prudent reserve. Next step for the committee to review and make a recommendation to change the prudent reserve.

- Attended 2 district meetings to provide a "face" of the district and general service. Plan is to do at least 2 of these a month
