



## District 21 – Placer County

### Motion #2025-03 (July 2025): Consider additional scholarships for the 2025 Election Assembly for GSRs whose groups cannot afford these expenses

- **Issue:** 2 GSR scholarships were previously approved for the Fall Election Assembly. The total unused funds in the GSR scholarships line item are \$1,020 (fewer scholarships awarded this year, and lower costs than anticipated), allowing for an additional 2 scholarships to be funded if approved.
- **Benefits:**
  - GSRs are voting members at Assemblies and help decide matters for Area 07. More District 21 participation equals increased input on Area issues, which ultimately impact groups.
  - At this 3-day (Friday evening through Sunday noon, 2 nights overnight) Assembly, GSRs will vote on important issues, including electing Officers for the upcoming two-year Panel 76, and the Area 07 Spending Plan for 2026.
  - This Assembly is more expensive because of a two-night stay, so scholarships will be of special value to groups who couldn't otherwise afford to send their GSRs.
- **The Election Assembly is November 15-15, 2025 in Tracy. Estimated Cost for 4 Scholarships:** Total includes transportation/mileage (with carpooling strongly encouraged), registration fees and ½ lodging cost. Scholarship recipients are responsible for any costs over this amount (ex: can't find a roommate, meals, etc.)

*\*Mileage cost may be less as carpooling is strongly encouraged, or public transport such as train could be feasible. Transportation costs could be slightly higher as costs such as parking and bridge tolls are also allowable. If members carpool, each can claim their portion but the full payment will go to the member whose car was driven.*
