As trusted servants, our job is to bring information to our Groups, in order that they may reach an informed Group Conscience. In passing along the Group Conscience, we are helping to maintain the unity and strength so vital to our fellowship. Let us, therefore, have: the patience and tolerance to listen while others share; the courage to speak up when we have something to share; and the wisdom to do what is right for our Group and AA as a whole.”</i> • Tradition 7: (LONG FORM): <i>“The AA groups themselves ought to be fully supported by the voluntary contributions of their own members. We think that each group should soon achieve this ideal; that any public solicitation of funds using the name of Alcoholics Anonymous is highly dangerous, whether by groups, clubs, hospitals, or other outside agencies; that acceptance of large gifts from any source, or of contributions carrying any obligation whatever, is unwise. Then, too, we view with much concern those AA treasuries which continue, beyond prudent reserves, to accumulate funds for no stated AA purpose. Experience has often warned us that nothing can so surely destroy our spiritual heritage as futile disputes over property, money and authority.”</i> • Concept 6: (LONG FORM) <i>“The Conference recognizes that the Charter and the Bylaws of the General Service Board are legal instruments; that the Trustees are thereby fully empowered to manage and conduct all of the world service affairs of Alcoholics Anonymous.
