- Declaration of Unity: "This we owe to AA's future: to place our common welfare first; to keep our Fellowship united. For on AA unity depend our lives and the lives of those to come."
- GSR Preamble: "We are the General Service Representatives. We are the link in the chain of communication for our groups with the General Service Conference and the world of AA. We realize the ultimate authority is a loving God as he may express himself in our Group Conscience. As trusted servants, our job is to bring information to our Groups, in order that they may reach an informed Group Conscience. In passing along the Group Conscience, we are helping to maintain the unity and strength so vital to our fellowship. Let us, therefore, have: the patience and tolerance to listen while others share; the courage to speak up when we have something to share; and the wisdom to do what is right for our Group and AA as a whole."
- Tradition 3 (Long Form): "Our membership ought to include all who suffer from alcoholism. Hence we may refuse none who wish to recover. Nor ought AA membership ever depend upon money or conformity. Any two or three alcoholics gathered together for sobriety may call themselves an AA group, provided that they have no other affiliation."
- Concept 3: "To ensure effective leadership, we should endow each element of AA the Conference, the General Service Board and its service corporations, staffs, committees and executives with a traditional 'Right of Decision'."
