Let us, therefore, have: the patience and tolerance to listen while others share; the courage to speak up when we have something to share; and the wisdom to do what is right for our Group and AA as a whole.”</i> • Tradition 11: (LONG FORM): <i>“Our relations with the general public should be characterized by personal anonymity. We think AA ought to avoid sensational advertising. Our names and pictures as AA members ought not be broadcast, filmed or publicly printed. Our public relations should be guided by the principle of attraction rather than promotion. There is never need to praise ourselves. We feel it better to let our friends recommend us.”</i> • Concept 11: (LONG FORM) <i>“The Trustees of the General Service Board act in two primary capacities: (a) With respect to the larger matters of over-all policy and finance, they are the principal planners and administrators. They and their primary committees directly manage these affairs.
