District 21 Placer County General Service held our monthly business meeting on April 23, 2024 with approximately 20 GSRs, Officers and appointed Chairs in attendance. We had a GSR Panel commenting on their learnings and fellowship from the Pre-Conference Assembly. There were 16 attendees from District 21, including 4 GSRs on scholarship whose groups could not otherwise afford to send them. The GSRs were especially impressed with the depth and breadth of reporting on Conference Agenda items. They also liked the playing card games, the Sunday AA meeting and the “Founders’ Writings” discussion.

Three GSRs requested and have been approved for scholarships for the Post-Conference Assembly. The group discussed a proposal to send 3 additional Officers/Committee Chairs to the remaining 2024 Assemblies (all other Officers and Committee Chairs are either funded or are also GSRs). It was the sense of the room that this should not be done at this time until we ensure that finances would permit this expenditure. The group agreed to revisit this idea after 2nd quarter financials are in.

GSRs got a copy of the information regarding a request to move forward on relocating the Archives. They understand to inquire with their groups about this and that they will be voting on a motion at the Post-Conference Assembly.

Our “Spotlight on Service” for April was H&I. Marilyn C., District H&I Rep, reported on H&I programs and the upcoming first-ever joint Northern/Southern CA H&I conference on May 3-5. She passed out a “help wanted” sheet for GSRs to talk about at their meetings and informed us about a new program that helps prison inmates get sponsors. Our PICPC Chair reported on progress in rejuvenating this function and is organizing a table and AA meetings for the two-day Placer Veteran’s “Stand Down” in May.

We briefly discussed the Northern CA Accessibilities Committee dissolution letter, and GSRs will spread the word that there are more discussions to come on this issue. As DCM (and a Grapevine Rep for Rocklin Fellowship), I asked GSRs to find out if their groups have a GV/LaV Rep and to let them know about the Area GV meeting on the last Wednesday of each month on Zoom.
