CNIA 07, District 21 Technology Committee Draft Proposal

Background

It is suggested that District 21 form a committee of trusted servants to manage our technology assets. Many A.A. districts and service entities organize their technology efforts by committee. Doing this would place us in accordance with A.A. experience and tradition. A committee would also aid in the maintenance and upkeep of the website, while better ensuring regular service rotation from panel to panel.

Committee Membership

A minimum of 3 with no more than 5 members is suggested to balance the load of responsibility and provide diversity of thought and opinion. The official service positions below along with 2 additional members already in service to the district, such as elected officers or active GSRs would be ideal. These positions are 2 year/1 panel commitments appointed by election.

Webmaster 2 year sobriety requirement

Alt-webmaster
1 year sobriety requirement

Virtual/hybrid meeting coordinator 1 year sobriety requirement

Technology chairperson can be elected by the committee members. Webmaster would be committee chairperson by default if no election held.

- Software subscriptions
- All other relevant technology items important to the district mission

The consideration of additional technological and/or digital needs of the district would be placed before the committee with recommendations offered at the district business meeting. In some instances the committee would have the traditional Right of Decision in accordance with Concept III of World Service and make final decisions within the committee.
